CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: CONSULTANT FOR DEVELOPING A UN ADVOCACY TRAINING MANUAL AND CURRICULUM FOR ASIAN HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENDERS

Background: The Asian Forum for Human Rights and Development (FORUM-ASIA) is a regional network of human rights organizations in Asia. Committed to promoting and protecting human rights, FORUM-ASIA works closely with human rights defenders (HRDs) across the region. To enhance the capacity of Asian HRDs in advocating for human rights at the United Nations (UN), FORUM-ASIA is seeking a qualified consultant to develop a comprehensive UN Advocacy Training Manual and Curriculum.

Objective: FORUM-ASIA is looking for an experienced consultant to develop a UN Advocacy Training Manual and Curriculum tailored to the needs of Asian HRDs. The manual and curriculum should empower HRDs to effectively engage with UN mechanisms, advocate for human rights, and navigate the complex UN system.

Scope of Work: The consultant's responsibilities will include:

- 1. **Needs Assessment:** Conduct a thorough needs assessment to understand the specific challenges and requirements of Asian HRDs in engaging with the UN system.
- 2. **Manual and Curriculum Development:** Develop a comprehensive UN Advocacy Training Manual and Curriculum that covers the following areas:
